

Mathematics

Place Value will start the term and the focus will be on solving problems with odd and even numbers, we will look at ways to use place value to add and subtract two two digit numbers and begin to use a number line to count on in tens and ones.

We have started to use TT Rock Stars and this will give the children lots of practise using their times tables for multiplication and division, this can then be linked to solving problems.

PSHE This is linked to friendship and will lead into Anti-Bullying week, giving the children the chance to think about being the best friend they can be and how to solve problems linked to falling out. We will work with children in the different classes to complete tasks.

Literacy:

In Literacy we will be using stories linked to penguins to create a means to retell and create our own stories. We will use the story Lost and Found and think of ways to describe this amazing part of our World. In skills work we will learn all about how to write a set of instructions, using bossy words and time phrases, we will create instructions for a perfect friend and think of ways to describe how to make a range of crafts for Christmas.

D&T/Art

The Antarctic colours will be the inspiration for our art work, colour mixing to create landscapes will lead to silhouette pictures and images of animals. We are using penguins as a source of information and will use this to create observational drawings and paintings.
