

## Mathematics

Place Value will start the term and the focus will be on looking at ways to show amounts in different ways. We will be solving problems adding and subtracting two two digit numbers as well as using the inverse to solve missing number problems. We will continue to use TT Rock Stars and the children will practise using their times tables for multiplication and division using the 2,3,5,10 times tables.

We will find fractions of objects, shapes and amounts.

We will also be practising telling the time and using different coins to make set amounts.

## PSHCE

Beginning with Our New Year Goals, we will be thinking about what we need to develop to become the best learners possible. We will plan goals for ourselves and for the class and think about ways to make sure we meet them!

## English:

English and History will be closely linked this term, with the use of The Great Fire of London and Samuel Pepys diaries to lead to detailed descriptions, poems, reports and diaries. We will be learning to add suffixes to create new words and practising using plurals and an apostrophe to show possession.

We will be reading a wide range of texts and making predictions about what will happen next as well as explaining why we think things happen in a story.

## Music

Music lessons will continue with Mrs Lawrence.

P.E. Our work with the sports coach will begin to focus on team games and skills involving working together.

## History

Samuel Pepys will lead our History Detective work as we discover the Great Fire of London through his diaries, paintings and our use of drama.
