

Mathematics

We will be starting off the term by looking at our calculation knowledge and improving our reasoning so that we know how to tackle an abstract looking problem. We will then be learning how to subtract fractions and use our knowledge of multiplication facts to broaden our understanding. We will also be focussing on geometry towards the end of the term.
