

Literacy:

This term, our Literacy will be based on both fiction and non-fiction texts, linking to our Pirate theme. We'll use our sentence 'Must Haves', conjunctions and suffixes to improve our writing; we'll also be encouraged to reread every piece of written work to check and improve upon it. We'll also have a greater emphasis this term on reading, both as a whole class and in groups to develop our comprehension skills and understanding of different texts.

RE:

We will be learning about the Judaism in RE this term; in particular looking at Shabbat. We will discover what Shabbat is and why it is so important for Jewish people.

Geography:

We'll be using our direction understanding from Maths and Computing to make and follow treasure maps. To do this, we'll look at aerial photographs and use these to compare England with a contrasting country.

Design Technology:

In DT we will be discovering where our food comes from. We will then look at healthy food options before designing, making and eating our own sandwiches.

Maths:

In Maths we will be looking at: position, number and measures. We will start by measuring masses using standard and non-standard units. We will then refine and use our position knowledge in computing. Our number work this term will include lots of problem solving and we will work on our number bonds for 20.

Science:

Our Science topic this term is Materials. We will be identifying different common materials and distinguishing between an object and the material that it is made from. We will then use this information in a topic context

PE:

In PE we will be learning how to play Rounders. We will practice throwing, catching and fielding before putting them together to play a competitive game.

PSHE:

This half term, our PSHE focus will be 'Relationships'. We will think about the people who are important to us and will talk about our emotions. Together, we'll think of ways to help us to control our emotions in different situations.

History:

We will be following our topic theme of 'Pirates' in History and will be finding out about the lives of famous pirates including Blackbeard and Anne Bonney.

Computing:

Our Computing this term will be based upon algorithms and programming. The children will use their knowledge of direction from Maths to produce algorithms and then use these to program bee-bots.
