Welcome back! I hope you all had a wonderfully relaxing half term break. The children have returned to school refreshed and enthusiastic about this terms topics. This week we held our first House Assemblies where we announced the winning team for term 1- Merlin! They earnt an incredible 1318 house points last term, far more than we had originally anticipated would be earnt. Because of this we have slightly adapted our original plan of awarding £50 charity donation three times a year, to now awarding £25 six times a year. This means that there are now more opportunities for the Houses to earn money for their chosen charity. A cheque for £25 is on its way to The British Heart Foundation along with a letter from Merlin team explaining how they had earnt their donation. The tubes in the corridor have now been emptied and are ready to start being filled with this terms House points.

It has been a busy start to what is traditionally a busy term, however today school seems unusually quiet. All of Key Stage 2 are out and about. You will have noticed the building of our Outdoor classroom has begun. It is looking fabulous and we are so grateful to the FODS for raising the money to purchase the building. The children and staff are looking forward to using it in the coming months. Thank you also to Russel Covill the carpenter, who has also braved the rain today to continue to build!

PARENTS EVENING BOOKING

On Monday 14th and Wednesday 16th November we are holding formal Parents Evenings for each class. This is an opportunity for you to discuss your child's learning and find out their current targets.

Today each child has been given a letter which contains your unique username and password for your eSchools account. When logged in you can book Parents Evening appointments, view your child's attendance, receive notices and messages, and also access information about your child's class. This is something new we have set up, so please bear with us if you have initial niggles with the system, we are learning too.

Seasonal Flu Vaccination Programme 2016-17

We have been asked by the Public Health Authority to promote the 'Seasonal Flu Vaccination Programme 2016-17.'

Flu can be a very unpleasant illness in children and can cause serious complications so it's important to protect children. Vaccinating children means the infection is less able to spread so it helps to protect their brothers and sisters, and other family members and friends including their parents and grandparents.

In Wiltshire, the following children are currently being invited for the flu vaccination by their GP practice:

- all children aged 2, 3 and 4 years born between 1st September 2011 and 31st August 2014
- all children aged 4 & 5 in reception year at school and;
- all children aged 2 to 17 years with long-term health conditions

Children in school years 1, 2 and 3 have been offered the vaccination in school by their school nursing team, this is booked for Friday 25th November'16. For these children, the flu vaccination is given as a nasal spray.

For information, pregnant women, those aged 65 and over, anyone under 65 who has a long-term health condition and carers are also eligible for the flu vaccination through their GP practice or participating local pharmacy.




