

Mathematics

This term is of course SATS term, so our maths will be linked to exploring all of the areas already covered to develop confidence and independence in solving problems.

Shape will be explored to enable us to compare and describe different 2-d and 3-d shapes and cross curricular links will be made in terms of measurement for length, height, capacity and temperature.

Through computing we will look at giving and following directions and talking about movement.

PSHCE

Helathy Bodies and Healthy Minds is the name of our topic for PSHCE, which will link to science as we explore ways to stay healthy, including looking at the food we eat and planning a healthy diet.

English:

We are using the Funny Bones stories this term to read, plan and write our own short stories. We will be using the skills of time adverbs and making correct use of the past tense. For our non- fictions genre we will be developing our ability to write clear instructions, focusing on adding detail, using bossy verbs and writing in the present tense.

Reading- we will use a range of books to develop our whole class approach to reading focusing on prediction, searching for words to improve our writing and asking and answering questions.

French

French lessons will continue with Mrs Sturm.

Music

Music lessons will continue with Mrs Lawrence.

P.E. Our work with the sports coach will begin to focus on team games and skills involving working together and will lead to football skills

Science

This term we will think about ways to become and stay healthy, including a need for healthy food, exercise and rest. We will think about our skeletons and what helps our bones to be strong as well as what our bones help us to do.

We will take time to investigate what we can do to stay healthy as well as sorting and exploring different types of food. This will lead to taste tests and developing different healthy fruit products.

Art- We will create our own skeleton paintings before focusing on the bones in our hand to make a working model.

Computing

We will continue to use online safety to think about using our new laptops appropriately as well as how online safety is important at home.

Skills will be linked to giving and following instructions to use directions as well as learning to save and retrieve work. We will practise our typing skills and look at different ways to present information when creating our Funny Bones books.

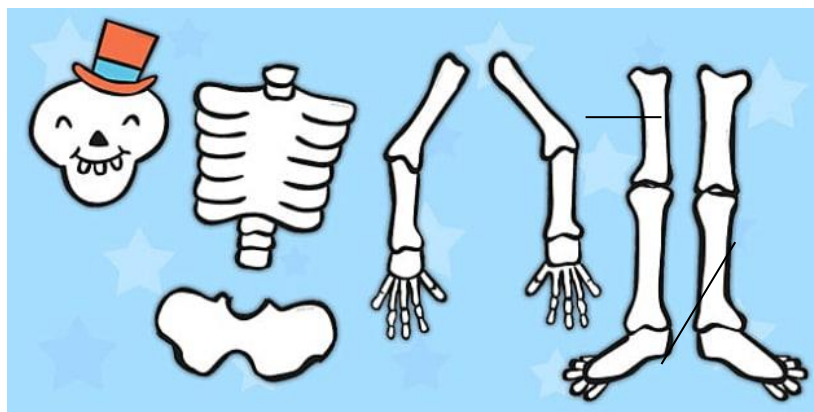
Geography
