It was like stepping back in time on Monday morning as the children, staff and parent helpers from Chestnut and Willow Classes arrived in school ready for their visit to The STEAM Museum in Swindon. Well done to all of you for the amazing costumes, it really helped bring an authentic feel to the trip. During the day lots of other visitors to the museum commented how amazing our group looked and of course how well they behaved. The children experienced life in the war from being evacuated and chosen at the railway station to life in the air raid shelters.





Thank you to Ash Class for their celebration assembly this week. It was lovely to hear what you have been learning over the last term. I particularly enjoyed hearing about life as a knight and of course your dragons. Please remember you are more than welcome to attend any of our Wednesday afternoon Celebration Assemblies.

Today there has been great excitement on the school field as members of Dilton History Society arrived on site with a team of archaeologists from Swindon. After the "dig site" had been chosen and precisely measured, the digging began. Groups of children have been helping to excavate a 1mx1m trench. Each Class has spent time visiting the site, and have enjoyed a talk from our visitors learning about how to prepare and carry out an archaeological dig. Less than an hour in and they had already found treasure – an old coin! Thank you very much to The History Society and the Archaeologist team, this has been a fantastic project for the children to be part of.



Our Easter Experience sessions have continued this week in the church, with all the classes visiting to take part in two work stations. The children were able to learn about and reflect on how Jesus was a servant and a king. They sat around the Last Supper table and learnt about how Jesus broke the bread and shared it with his disciples.




