#### **Mathematics**

In maths we will be continuing to revise and deepen our learning further. We will start with looking at negative numbers, revising Roman numerals and counting in different multiples. We will also be linking our maths understanding to the outdoors and the texts we are reading in class.

## D&T/Art

In Art we will be looking at an example of digital art and discussing different mediums. We will be recreating the painting using our own choice of materials. We will also be looking at engineering and how bridges are constructed on a grand scale.

## Science

In Science we are looking at habitats and what living things need to survive. We will be comparing habitats and look at classification keys to compare and contrast a variety of different living things. We will also link our science to sustainability and look at how the changes to the environment affect different habitats.

## Religious Education

In RE we are starting the term by looking at the Jewish rites of passage and questioning when we think you become an adult. We will also be looking at Buddhism and the 8-fold path.

#### **PSHE**

In PSHE we will be focussing on 'relationships' in the context of friendship and family. We will work on looking at positive friendships and the importance of friends and how we have to often tolerate others.

# Literacy:

For this term, our topic is going to be focussing on water. We are going to start by revising the water cycle and looking at the formation of rivers. This will help with lend itself to our first literacy unit, focussing on poetry, performance and shape poems. We will be writing poems in the style of a river journey. Next, we will be looking into sustainability and writing persuasively to conserve water. We will also be writing a biography of a famous engineer!
