Literacy:

This term we will be refining our 'Must Haves' for sentence writing: capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and checking that we have all the required sounds in our words. We will also be picking up some additional skills including: use of?, adjectives and suffixes. We will be doing this through factual writing about castles, descriptive writing, diary entries for our seeds and poetry.

RE:

We will be thinking about how we greet and treat people who are special to us. We will then look at how the people of Jerusalem greeted Jesus in the Easter Story. Looking at the story in detail, we will talk about the symbols of the palm leaf and the cross.

History:

This term, we will learn about the importance and role of castles. We will observe similarities and differences between Stone Keep and Motte and Bailey castles, looking at internal and external features. We will also learn about the sorts of people who lived or worked in castles and what they did, exploring this through film and drama.

PE:

In PE we will be taking part in a 'Knight Training' program. We will learn how to move undetected and refine our balance and agility skills. We will also learn how to move along a bench and jump off safely, by adopting the squat position.

Science:

This term we will be learning about Plants. We have a special mission to become a Castle Gardener so we will be planting and observing the growth of a plants in different locations. We will also be looking at deciduous and evergreen plants, naming a few of each.

Maths:

In Maths we will be finding $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of a shape or an amount. We will then move on to Money. We will be looking at the different denominations of coins and notes and will be using this to solve simple problems. We will also be conducting some simple multiplication and division later on in the term.

Geography:

Design Technology:
