I hope that you are all well and keeping safe. Please find an overview of the activities set for this week. Please do not worry about completing it all just complete what you can.



Please keep all work together in the book that I sent home, do not worry about trying to upload it to eschools.

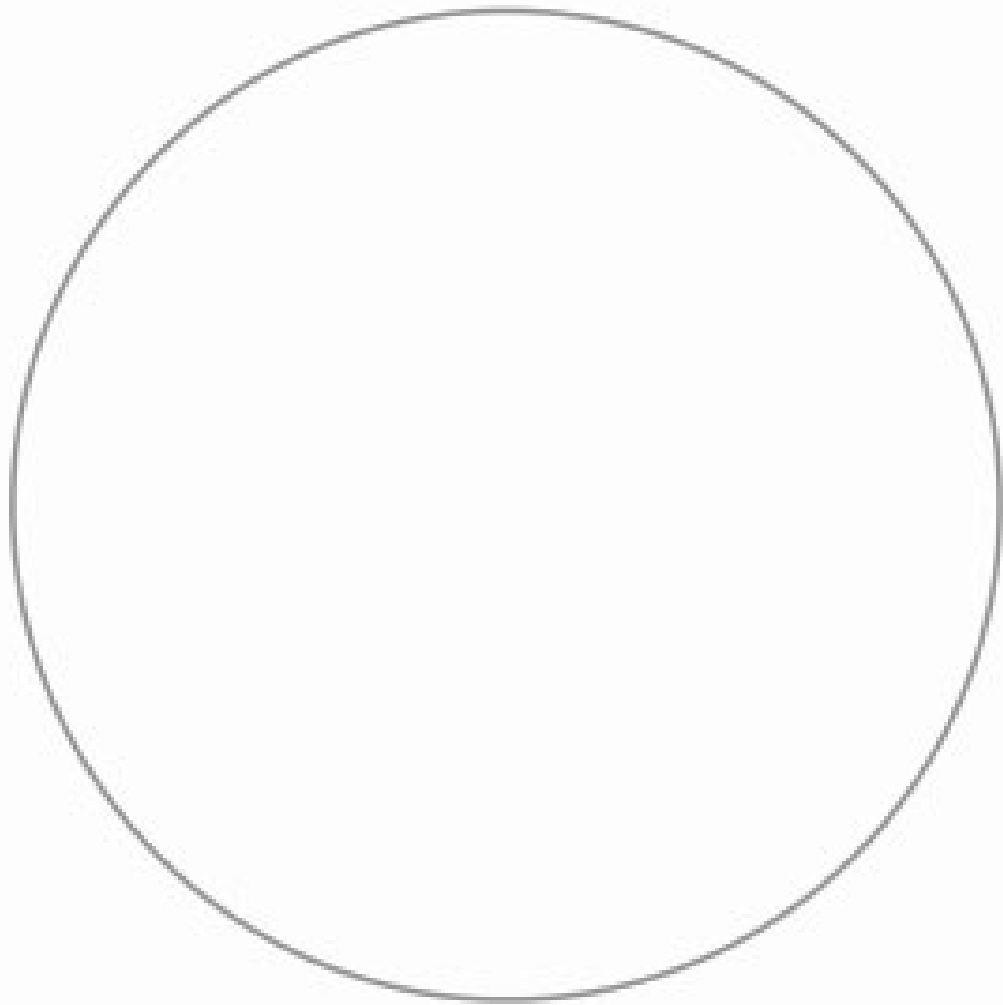
Maths	Phonics	Reading

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Remember to print from page 2 to avoid wasting paper and ink.

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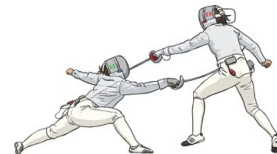
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KEY CONCEPT/MESSAGE:
