Absence reporting and lateness

Please can I remind you that any absence must be reported directly to the school office. This can be done via email (sc@diltonmarsh.wilts.sch.uk), by telephoning the school or by coming into the school office in person. Please do not send absence messages via elder siblings, other parents or staff around the school site. Dental and Doctors appointments should ideally be made outside of school hours unless an emergency. Absence for Hospital or Paediatrician's appointments should be supported by an appointment letter which we will ask to copy. If there is any unknown absence by 9am, then we will phone to clarify the reason.

We are also noticing that some children are repeatedly arriving late for school. Some mis-haps or reasons for occasion lateness are inevitable. Repeated lateness however, would perhaps suggest a change in morning routines are needed. Children arriving late is disruptive for their learning and the learning of the rest of the class. We will monitor lateness patterns alongside attendance and teachers will share any concerns they may have. Thank you for your support with these procedures.
