- To identify and remove barriers to pupils' learning and make reasonable adjustments
- To adapt and customise curriculum materials
- To support the wellbeing and mental health of pupils with SEND
- To contribute to the management of SEND pupils' behaviour
- To support the delivery of additional interventions for improving pupils' well-being.
- To promote SEND pupils' resilience
- To safeguard the welfare of SEND pupils
- To act as a champion and advocate for pupils with SEND
- To escort and supervise pupils on educational visits and out of school activities.
- To contribute to the writing of learner profiles
- To communicate with other professionals from within school and from external agencies where appropriate in order to support pupils' learning and well-being.
- To take responsibility in developing continuing professional development.
- To work collaboratively with class teacher
- To undertake any other duties commensurate with the post, as allocated by the Headteacher.
