Dear parents and carers

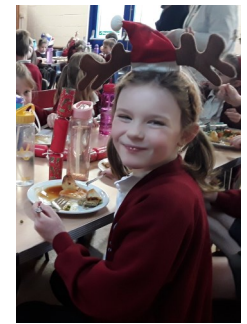
We have had a lovely and very busy end to Term 2, despite some very unwelcome bugs and viruses which have affected many of our children and staff.
