We urgently require a Breakfast Assistant to join our successful morning team - Monday to Friday (term time only) 7.30 – 8.30 am. Duties will include preparing breakfast and organising activities for them to share.

We intend to open an After School Club at the beginning of the new academic year (September'16) and we need to recruit a motivated team to assist in the setting up and running of this much needed service.
