Thank you to our band of cleaners who have gone over and above to ensure every surface is cleaned to an inch of it's life!

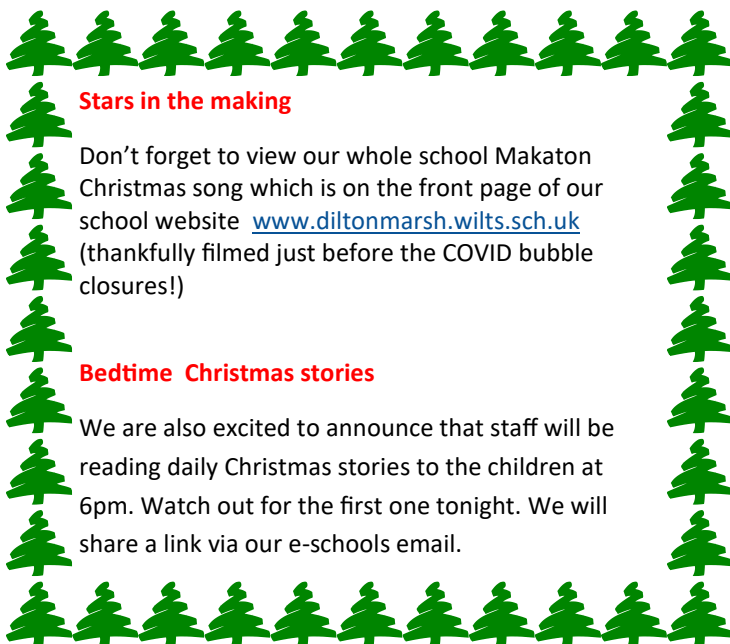
Thank you to Mrs Smith for all the jobs she has had this term – dinner lady, toilet cleaner, playground assistant, TA, and anything else I've missed!
