What is the Dilton Marsh Neighbourhood Plan?

- A document that will set out planning policies for the Parish which will be used by Wiltshire Council when considering planning applications.
- It will define the use and development of land and buildings.
- It will detail a Vision for the future of our village and will identify important features.
- It will be written by the local community, the people who know and love the area, led by the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group.
