
This term there will be a theme for each week and most of your learning for the week will be based around that theme. This week our theme is Rumble in the Jungle.









Over half the world's species of plants and animals live in the jungle! The jungle is very warm and very wet!

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
Jungles are overgrown with lots of tangled vegetation and dense forests! Thousands of insects live in one jungle tree!


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Tree's leaves can stretch out as wide as a football pitch above the canopy! Scientists sometimes use hot air balloons to study the top of the canopy!

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The jungle is very dark. Only 1% of the jungle has sunlight because of the shade from the trees!


Bird-eating spiders in the Amazon Rainforest can grow as big as dinner plates!

Mum sighed and asked Sam and Vashti to go and look for the top sheet.


"I think it blew over there," said Vashti, pointing into the woods

"Well this has been an adventure already," said Mum. "Just not the one we were expecting!"



















Caterpillar Tricky Word Matching
