You may already have heard the children talking this week about how we are developing a "Growth Mindset" at school. The staff spent the morning on Tuesday learning all about the research by Prof. Carol Dweck into Fixed and Growth Mindsets and the effect these have on learning. Each class has started to look at and learn about how our brains work and linking this to the two types of mindsets that children and adults can have, a "fixed" mindset and a "growth mindset". Below is an overview of the traits of each:

#### **Fixed Mindset**

- I like my work to be easy
- I don't like to try a challenge
- I want people to praise me for how clever I am
- I believe I cannot change how clever I am
- I don't like to try new things because I won't be very good at it
- I give up when it gets hard

#### **Growth Mindset**

- I never give up
- I like my work to be difficult
   it means I am learning
- I love challenges
- I want people to praise me for the effort I put into my work
- I believe I can get more intelligent by working hard
- I feel clever when I'm learning something new
- I learn from my mistakes

## Our aim is to become a "Growth Mindset" school where challenge is celebrated and success is measured by how hard you try.

It has been proven that having a Growth Mindset can improve children's progress and attainment. As a result, we are teaching our children that by having a Growth Mindset they can grow their brains and intelligence and achieve anything they want!


