

# Final call for all parents not already registered for childcare vouchers

Government has announced that the childcare voucher scheme will close to new entrants on 6 April 2018. Any working parent who currently uses registered childcare (or plans to use registered childcare in future) needs to sign up to their employer's childcare voucher scheme **AND RECEIVE A VOUCHER** by 5 April.


Then they can take their time deciding if vouchers or TFC is the better scheme for their family (they can switch to TFC, even after April 2018, but they can't switch from TFC to childcare vouchers).

If they don't register and receive a childcare voucher by 5 April 2018, then TFC will be their only option (and that's assuming they'll be eligible).

There's lots of eligibility criteria for TFC. Parents can't be in receipt of Universal Credit/tax credits and both parents have to be working. And analysis by Employers for Childcare shows that the majority of working families will be better off with childcare vouchers, tax credits or a combination of both.

Even if parents don't need childcare vouchers immediately, they can simply register on their employer's scheme today and place an order for the minimum amount. As long as they receive a childcare voucher from their employer in every rolling 12-month period, they'll remain on the scheme.\*

\* Any parent who's already registered for childcare vouchers can carry on ordering them even after April 2018, providing they've received a voucher in the last rolling 12-month period. For example, if they last received a childcare voucher on 25 May 2017 they need to receive their next voucher on or before 25 May 2018 to remain eliqible.
