Dear parents,

Who would ever imagine the end of Term 4 would be so quiet? At school we have carried on with our Easter activities, making cards, creating gifts and designing and building a vehicle to carry eggs. Staff not in school are kept busy completing online training or writing the children's Annual Report, whilst juggling their own childcare or family responsibilities. Annual Reports will be sent home in the first week after Easter.

We are preparing for the current situation to continue after the Easter holidays. Teachers have already started to plan work for the children which will be available each week. Don't forget if you have any difficulties accessing work give us a ring. Phones are always manned until 11am and we are happy to print out work and leave them in the entrance for you to collect at your convenience.

Just as we finished school we set up the children's pages where they can submit their work. They can use this page to chat to their teachers and to their friends. All the teachers have access to the chats so can monitor to ensure that all conversations follow our e-safety rules. If your child was away at that time they may not have taken home or collected their log in so please get in contact and we can send that information.

This week we have been busy organising Easter care for families of Key Workers. This will take place at The Avenue School in Warminster. We will re-open Dilton for our Key Worker and Vulnerable families after that. We have also been sent information about the supply of Free School Meal vouchers from the start of Term 5. We will be sending home shopping vouchers but these are only for children in receipt of Free School Meals, not those children in Lime, Cherry and Ash classes who receive Universal Infant Free School Meals.
