#### Dear parents and carers

As Covid rates rise across the county and particularly in secondary school pupils we will return to some of our protection measures next week in order to try to reduce infection rates between pupils, staff and other adults. We will reduce contact between different classes inside by returning to the children eating in the classrooms, or outside if the dry weather persists, and adults will return to wearing masks when in communal areas.

On Monday and Tuesday we have Parents meetings. I have toyed with the idea of cancelling these but feel with protective measures in place it is important that they continue. Protective measures will include:

- Asking parents to wait for their appointment at the outside classroom door, not walk through the school.
- Please arrive shortly before your time to avoid contact with other parents.
- Staff will endeavour to ensure that appointments run to time in order to avoid unnecessary waiting.
- Within the classroom we will keep to 2m distance rules.

If you feel uncomfortable with the measures put in place please email the class email account to request a phone call. Please note it may not be possible to organise these for this term.
