



Dear Parents

This week in school we have been preparing for the return of our Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 pupils. This has involved in moving excess furniture out of classrooms to ensure there is plenty of circulation space around the tables. In addition, we have been preparing individual pencil packs so that children do not share resources. However we change the physical space please be reassured that the caring and nurturing side of school still remains and we can't wait to support the children in getting back to a new school routine.

Over the whole school we have 73% of our children attending next week at some point. We have contacted all the parents of the children who are not attending with details of how we can contact the children remotely. Through TEAMS they will meet with an adult in the school to show them what school looks like and have a catch up. It is really important that the families participate in this to ease some of the anxiety of returning after such a long time away from school. If your child is not returning and you have not received this information from the class emails please contact the school office.

There have been much speculation around what school will look like in September but we are still awaiting guidance from the DfE. They have, however, informed us that they do not intend to ask schools to remain open over the summer period for the children of critical workers. We are currently collating an overview of the paid-for holiday provision that will be available over the summer break for families that would like to access this. Once the guidance for September has been published we will, of course, update you.
