

## Mathematics

During the next two terms we will be covering a wide range of maths including: Place Value, Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Fractions, Decimals and Geometry. As a school, we are now following White Rose Maths – this will ensure that your child is covering the whole National Curriculum. The children will also be continuing their times tables and arithmetic every morning. As a school, we are also introducing a programme of work called No Nonsense Maths which will take the children back to the basics in order to help them build to more difficult maths problems.

## PSHE

In PSHE we are focussing on how to create a happy school. They will learn how to work better in groups, how to respect other people's views and opinions and finally, how to become good role models to the younger children.

## English

Writing – The children will be writing a number of different genres of text including: Descriptions, Letters, Mystery Stories, Diary Entries and a Dual Narrative.

Reading – Our two books up until Christmas are Skellig and A Christmas Carol. I'm very excited to share these books with the children. They are very different and will test the children's reading skills and comprehension.

## P.E.

As a school we welcome Mr McCarthy to Dilton Marsh. He will become a valued member of the school and teach PE to all the children. This term, the children will be learning about different Games and their rules.

## Music

Music lessons will continue with Mrs Lawrence. They are going to work on performing using different idioms.
