

Learning highlights

Chestnut Class made a human version of the inner workings of the ear. Rhys explained, "When a sound is made it gets to your ear, then travels down the ear canal, hits the ear drum then knocks 3 bones (the tiniest in the human body) called the hammer, anvil and stirrup. Then the cochlear turns the sound into electrical signals which travel through the brain and then the brain tells you that you have heard a sound".
