

# PLEASE RESPECT THE NEIGHBOURS AND LOCAL RESIDENTS...

Despite our many pleas for drivers not to block or turn by the school gates or on peoples private driveways, we are still receiving complaints of repeated incidents and concerns for children's safety BOTH outside the school gates and along The Hollow.

The Police are now involved following many complaints and concerns – people have even been seen reversing down School Lane where children are crossing – many children walk on their own and most are smaller than the height of a car so would not be seen!!! Please don't make this a horrific incident.

The private driveway off School Lane has now been coned following some damage to the wall – please respect these and do not attempt to turn in that area – it is a private driveway!

It is an offence to block private driveways and school entrances and we are incredibly concerned, not only about upsetting our local residents, but about an accident involving a child. There is plenty of space to park along the High Street on both sides of the road and Bev, the Lollipop Lady is there to help safely cross the road if necessary.
